

**Anglesey Sea Zoo & Marine Resource Centre**  
**On Site Facilities Summary at Wales' Largest Marine Aquarium**

Anglesey Sea Zoo aims to provide a fun and educational experience for groups, families and individuals of all ages, within a friendly family atmosphere. All the species in our care, other than a few specific to international conservation programmes, are native to Britain. We also use predominantly local producers and stockists for both our coffee and gift shops and all our services and information can be provided through the medium of Welsh and English. Other European languages can also occasionally be catered for.

We believe in providing value for money to all our guests, and aim to offer as much variety as possible to people of all ages that visit the Anglesey Sea Zoo. We recommend that visitors allow themselves several hours to see everything on site - ideally a whole day for group visits. Most of the facilities below are available free of charge to every visitor to the Anglesey Sea Zoo without advance booking, although some can be booked in advance. Please contact us for details.

Below is a summary of just some of the more practical things that we offer to make your visit more enjoyable.

**1. Pirates Adventure Playground**

This is an unsupervised but safe play area for kids with wood chippings for ground coverage. It has everything from ships and slides to walking the plank! A full risk assessment is available on request should groups require it.

**2. The Pirate Blaster**

A High pressure pirate fun water jet blaster!

**3. Captain Jake's Crazy Golf**

A nine hole pirate themed mini crazy golf course. Can you beat the dreaded Captain Jake?

**4. Bouncy Castle**

A massive Octojump marine themed bouncy castle. This is unsupervised during quiet periods but an attendant may be made available during busy times.

**5. Sea Dog Area**

A dedicated area for pet sea dogs. Each canine pen is open air, secure, shaded, and is provisioned with bowls and fresh water. There is no charge for this facility and it may be booked in advance during busy periods. Padlocks may be borrowed from the admissions counter on request.

**6. Dedicated Coach Parking Area**

For large groups, those made up of lots of children, or those with particular access needs, a dedicated coach parking area is available throughout the year. It is recommended that this be booked in advance during busy periods. There is no charge for this facility.

**7. Full Disabled Access**

The whole aquarium and grounds has full disabled access for wheelchair users throughout and there is a disabled toilet at the entrance, making us an ideal venue for groups with special needs or disabilities.

**8. Baby facilities**

The whole aquarium is accessible to pushchairs and prams, and baby changing facilities are available at three locations throughout the site, these are accessible to both mums and dads! In our coffee shop, high chairs and organic and non-organic baby food and milk are available, and we can also heat up your own baby food.

**9. Gift Shop**

Anglesey's best toy and gift shop! Everything from shark grabbers, toys and games, to nice but nautical household gifts, home-made fudge, a large selection of sweets, as well as books for all ages in both Welsh and English. You can even fish for your very own Pearl!

**10. Coffee Shop**

We offer varied menus designed for children and adults alike, all from produce sourced locally. Every meal is freshly prepared from the finest local ingredients, so during busy periods there may be a short wait, but it is worth it! Should you or any member of your group have any specific dietary requirements then please do contact us in advance and we will endeavour to meet your needs.

**11. Bicycle stands**

A place to, well, keep yer bike! We offer concessionary rates to those travelling by people power or by public transport to the Anglesey Sea Zoo.

**12. Beach safaris**

Beach safaris are particularly recommended for groups of children, ages 4 upwards. They involve groups being taken from the Anglesey Sea Zoo to the adjacent shoreline, a distance of approximately 200m, to see the unique coastal habitats of North Wales, and to search for marine creatures in the rock pools and along the shoreline. We provide everyone with a pair of wellies and an expert marine biologist as a guide. All you need is enthusiasm! Please see our education packs for more details.

**13. Fish Feeds**

At least one of our aquarium species will be fed each day, along with a talk about the species in question, this normally happens at around 3 pm and does not require booking in advance. Please note that most aquarium species eat a lot less during colder weather, so some feeds may not take place at certain times of year.

**14. Diver Displays**

On some days a diver will be immersed in one of our larger aquaria, again this will be accompanied by a talk about the persons activities and diving science in general, this normally takes place around 12.30 pm and once more it does not require booking in advance.

**15. Gator Boats**

Try to navigate a crocodile infested swamp in our remote controlled air boats!

**16. Telescopes**

An Owl's eye view through our owl telescope of the beautiful Menai Strait and the Snowdonia Mountain Range.
